The NEA, MSEA and applicable LOCAL Funds for Children and Public Education collect voluntary contributions from Association members and use those contributions for political purposes, including but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for federal, state and local offices. Only U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents may contribute to the NEA, MSEA and applicable LOCAL Funds. Contributions to the Funds for Children and Public Education are voluntary, making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. Although the NEA, MSEA, and LOCAL Funds for Children and Public Education request an annual contribution of \$1.00 per paycheck this is only a suggestion. Any member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status or right to benefits in NEA or any of its Associations.

I understand that I am making a joint contribution to the Funds for Children and Public Education and the contribution will be distributed evenly among the NEA FCPE, the MSEA FCPE and the local FCPE.

Contributions or gifts to the NEA, MSEA, and LOCAL Funds for Children and Public Education are not deductible for federal income tax purposes.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect the name, mailing address, occupation, and the name of employer for each individual whose contributions to the NEA Fund for Children and Public Education aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Federal law prohibits the NEA Fund for Children and Public Education from receiving donations from persons other than members of the NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates and their immediate families will be returned forthwith.
