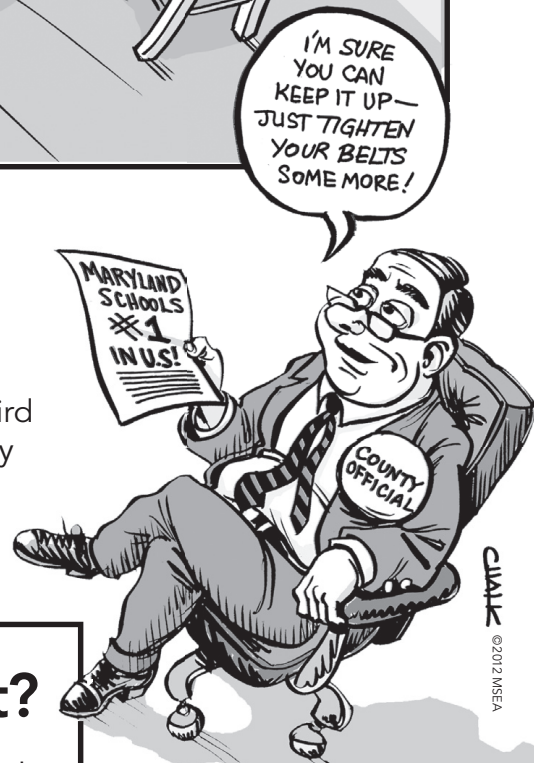


RAISE YOUR HAND IF THIS LOOKS FAMILIAR

Maryland's maintenance of effort (MOE), originally intended to protect school funding, is badly broken. Now, nearly one-third of Maryland's counties are slashing per-pupil funding—some by nearly 30%. Schools are being forced to raise class sizes and cut student programs, and our paychecks are stuck in the mud with increased costs for benefits and stalled salaries.
